Abu Hurayrah (Radhiallaahu anhu) reports: Rasulullah (Sallallaahu alaihi wasallam) said: "There are three people whose 'Dua' is not rejected; the fasting person until he breaks the fast, the just ruler, and the oppressed person, whose 'Dua' Allah lifts above the clouds and opens unto it the doors of heaven, and Allah says: "I swear by My honour, verily I shall assist you, even though it may be after some time." Hadith

Hadhrat Aisha (RadhiAllaho anha) reports: I said: 'O Messenger of Allah (Sallallaahu alaihi wasallam), should I find myself the 'Laylatul Qadr', what shall I pray? The Prophet answered: Say *Allaahumma innaka 'afuwwun tuhibbul-'afwa fa'fu'anni* (O, Allah! You are the Forgiving, You love to forgive. Forgive me!) Hadith

"Whoever gave a fasting person water to drink, Allah shall grant that giver a drink from my fountain, such a drink where after that person shall never again feel thirsty until he enters Jannah." Hadith
